In a continued effort to improve the electric infrastructure that serves our community, the City of Fallon will be conducting a planned power outage today, October 26, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. Please plan for today's outage to last approximately 30 minutes.

In most circumstances, the City of Fallon is able to notify customers of planned outages well in advance of a utility interruption. However, it is imperative that the infrastructure upgrades associated with today's planned outage not be delayed.

WHY ARE WE TURNING OFF YOUR POWER?

We need to make some improvements to the power system in your neighborhood. Most of the time, we can do this with no impact to you. WHAT YOU CAN DO:
